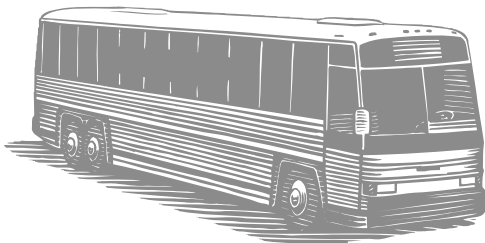

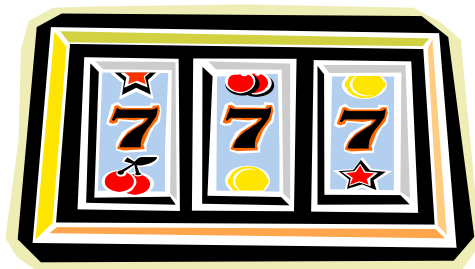

WHY SHOULD I CARE?

What difference does it make? What's the big deal? Teens often get a bad rap when it comes to showing interest in anything other than their ipod, myspace, or the opposite sex. Sunday October 15, immediately following the 5:30 Youth Mass from 7-8:30 PM in the parish hall, all high school aged teens are invited to see just how bored they can be when youth ministry presents an "Apathy Party." No sudden movements, facial expressions, or anything other than a monotone voice will be allowed in any way. Come in a way that shows that you just don't care.

SHARE YOUR FAITH WITH OUR CHILDREN

At the Sunday 10:30 am Family Mass we will be initiating a new program called, Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW). CLOW allows the children in grades k-3 to have an opportunity to hear God's Word proclaimed and explained to them in a meaningful way that is age appropriate. At the beginning of the Mass before the scripture readings, the Deacon or Priest calls the Ministers of the Word forth to receive the children's lectionary and they are sent forth with the children to a nearby meeting room. The children rejoin their families after the homily to celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist.
