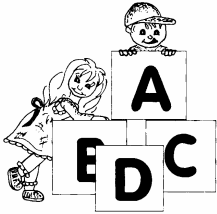
ENGLISH BIBLE STUDY

He is a gifted homilist and is known for his powerful and inspirational music; generously sharing his strong tenor voice with his appearances at fundraising concerts. He was once used by the Lord during his ministration of the sacrament of the "Anointing of the Sick; Msgr. Brennan prayed over a person scheduled for gallbladder surgery. Subsequent pre-op ultrasound tests revealed the gallstones had disappeared and the surgery was thereby cancelled. Confirmation and LIFE TEEN

The Model and vision of youth ministry and sacramental preparation for teenagers at our parish is growing. We had an overwhelming response at our first LIFE Night and our Candidate Sponsor session last weekend - so much so, that we have more young people than we have adults available to serve them. In addition to core members, two adult catechists are needed for immediate preparation for confirmation, one male and one female to lead 8 small group sessions of a same sex group of about 8-10 teens and assist with a few large groups sessions between now and May.

We also need 2 families within the parish who are willing to host these meetings. Training and support will be provided. If you feel called to share your time and your faith with young people please contact the youth ministry office immediately.

Developmental Assets

Search Institute has identified a set of 40 building blocks of healthy development – 20 internal and 20 external - that help young people grow up healthy, caring and responsible. Each week an asset will be identified with tips on how to help build that asset at home or in the congregation. Asset #3 is Other Adult Relationships – Kids know other adults besides their parents they can turn to for advice and support. They have frequent, in-depth conversations with them. 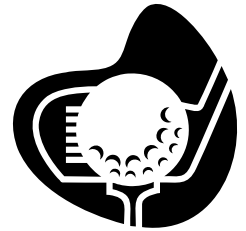

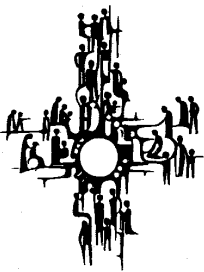

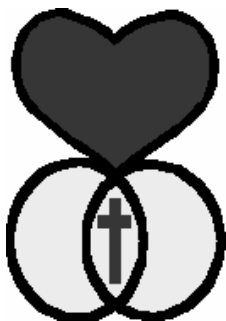

Scrip for Sale

Saint Linus School sells gift certificates (**Scrip**) from various vendors outside of church from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon every Sunday. Don't forget to stop by to pickup scrip for your grocery shopping or gas. Gift Certificates make wonderful presents too!

- **What is scrip?** SCRIP is a certificate which has the same face value as money. It is redeemable for food or merchandise purchases at supermarkets, department stores, gas stations, and restaurants. Scrip is purchased at St. Linus School for face value and is used as regular money at the specific merchants offered through our program. The school receives a portion of the certificate face value. To the user, scrip is the equivalent of regular money; to St. Linus School it represents additional funds.
