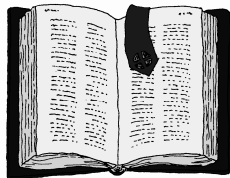

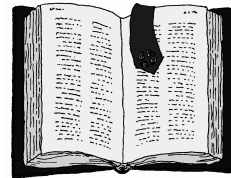

With the January anniversary of the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court Decision, we will see many pro-life events taking place across our state and nation, and we too will take this opportunity to affirm, as an Archdiocese, our commitment to life.

Gathering as an Archdiocesan Family, with the Auxiliary Bishops, priests, deacons, religious and faithful, singing the music of the *Shantigarh Requiem for the Unborn*, we will celebrate a moving liturgy. Before the close of the Mass, there will be a special candle-lighting ceremony - one candle for each life lost to abortion that day in the County of Los Angeles. Honoring these brief lives is a particularly poignant and inspiring moment, the memory of which will remain with you long after all have returned home.

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord

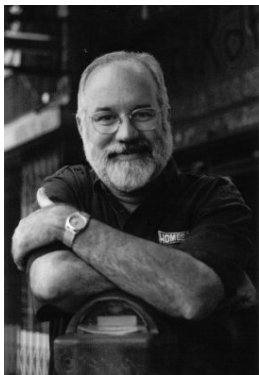
The feast of the Baptism of the Lord marks the **end of the Christmas Season** and the **beginning of Ordinary Time**. Its theme of light and revelation flow out of these days after Epiphany; and the Gospel for today stands first in the long sequence of readings about Jesus' teachings, healings, and miracles that characterize the season of ordinary Time.

Baptisms at St. Linus- The Process

Baptisms are celebrated on Saturdays at 10:00 am in the church. There is an option for a weekend Baptism during mass for those who attend mass at St. Linus and are registered in the parish. For those interested in having their child baptized at St. Linus, here are the requirements:

1. Come to the parish office to fill out the registration form for baptism
 2. Bring your child's Birth certificate to the parish office at the time of registration.
 3. \$35 fee payable at the time of registration
 4. Parents must attend interview with the Deacon couple.
 5. Parents and God Parents must attend the Baptismal Class.
 6. Godparents must be practicing Catholics and fully initiated, meaning they need to have already received the sacraments of initiation; Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation. If they are married, they must be married in the Catholic Church, able to receive Holy Communion.
- A non-Catholic may serve as a Christian witness, in which case, the child must have at least one fully initiated practicing Catholic Godparent.
7. The baptism date will be set at the parental interview.

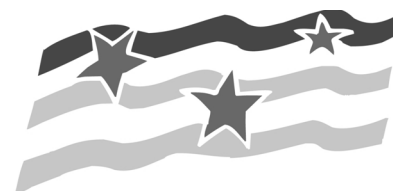
St. Linus School's OPEN HOUSE coming in January!

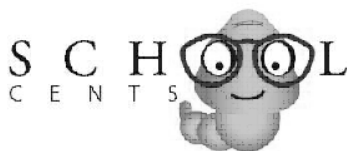
