To accomplish this mission, there are certain essential values professed and maintained by those involved in LIFETEEN. These values are woven into the fabric of who we are as Catholic Christians, and they form the foundation for everything we do. They define the nature of our relationships and pave the road of our individual and communal walk of faith. As a ministry, LIFETEEN embraces seven essential values. Each week we look at one of those values.

1. LOVE
2. A SPIRIT OF EVANGELIZATION
3. JOY - We live by an unrelenting belief in the goodness of God, and in His desire not for our momentary happiness, but our everlasting life. The spirit of LIFE TEEN is one of true joy, keeping life in perspective and allowing the peace of God to reign in our hearts, regardless of what the world might bring at any given moment.

He is the former Provincial of his Order, former Director of the San Bernardino Diocese Charismatic Renewal Center and the Evangelization Ministries. 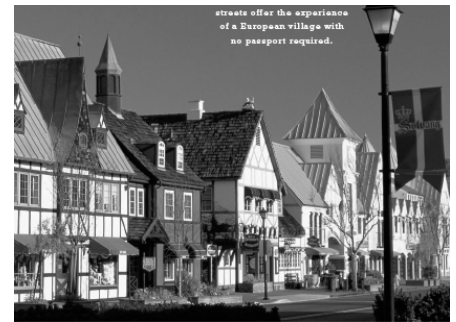
