Reverend Fr. Mike Sears is the Pastor of Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Los Nietos. Father Mike has an extensive healing ministry. He is a speaker at the Medjugorje Peace Conference and at the annual SCRC Charismatic Convention. Fr. Sears has the charismatic gift of healing. Last May 19, 2003, at St. John the Baptist Church's (Costa Mesa) Healing Mass, a skeptical non-Catholic believer, diagnosed with Throat Cancer attended the Mass. She was preparing for throat surgery and removal of the throat "mass" that was bulging from her neck. God's Holy Spirit must have touched and healed her through Fr. Sears' ministry because the lengthy surgery revealed no cancer cells in her throat; a concrete manifestation of God's power and loving presence in the person's life – that our God is a healing God. Come and receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

The Catholic Relief Services Collection

This week, our parish will take up "The Catholic Relief Services Collection"

This collection makes possible the American Catholic Church's global mission to combat poverty, provide relief and development, assist refugees and immigrants, and advocate for justice and peace in situations of conflict and neglect of basic human rights. Please help by giving to this collection.

Who are the candidates?

Catechumens are people who have never been baptized and are now preparing to be baptized, confirmed and welcomed to the Lord's table at the Easter Vigil through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (commonly called the RCIA). Often there are others who have already been baptized and who now desire to become fully initiated members of the Catholic church. They, too, undergo a period of formation based on the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults; they are called candidates because they are discerning a call to complete their initiation.

Like those whom we welcome into our own families through marriage or adoption, the candidates bring with them a wide variety of experiences and traditions. Some of them may have been baptized in another faith tradition; they now wish to enter into full communion with the Catholic church. Normally they are confirmed and receive their first communion at the time of their reception at the Easter Vigil.

Other candidates may have been baptized Catholic, usually as infants, but received no further formation in the Catholic faith. They, too, are preparing for confirmation and first communion.

They may need a more extended period of formation and catechesis, similar to that of the catechumens. In both cases, active participation in the Sunday liturgy, prayerful reading of the scriptures and an increasing awareness of the church's teachings and mission are the primary means of preparation.

At the end of this period of preparation, those candidates who were baptized in another tradition are welcomed into the Catholic church through a simple act of reception. All the candidates are then confirmed and welcomed to the Lord's table (Holy Communion) for the first time. This celebration ideally takes place at the Easter Vigil.

The newly confirmed now take their place in the assembly and continue to do what Christians have done throughout the ages: offer thanks and praise to God and spread the good news of God's love and reconciliation.

This year's candidate is Jerry. Please pray for him.

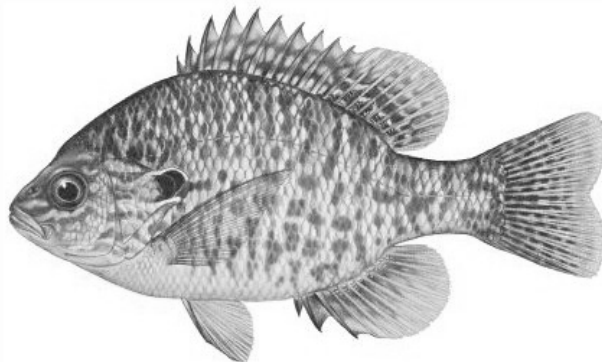
