LIFE TEEN – Seven Essential Values

LIFE TEEN exists to lead teens and their families closer to Christ. That is our mission. To accomplish this mission, there are certain essential values professed and maintained by those involved in LIFE TEEN. These values are woven into the fabric of who we are as Catholic Christians, and they form the foundation for everything we do. They define the nature of our relationships and pave the road of our individual and communal walk of faith. As a ministry, LIFE TEEN embraces seven essential values. Each week we look at one of those values.

1. LOVE
2. A SPIRIT OF EVANGELIZATION
3. JOY
4. FAITHFULNESS TO OUR PRIMARY VOCATION
5. AFFIRMATION
6. AUTHENTICITY
7. A EUCHARISTIC SPIRITUALITY - We seek to become one with Christ in all ways. Through a strong devotion to the Blessed Mother, we develop a

more profound understanding of Jesus Christ. Through the Holy Scriptures, we grow in sanctity through the Incarnate Word. Through openness to the Charisms of the Holy Spirit, we allow God's love to permeate this world. Through adherence to the Church that our Lord established, we act in obedience and humility. Through our frequenting of the Sacraments, especially the Eucharist in Most Holy Communion, we become one with the living God. These intimate experiences with Christ are unmistakable signs of His love.

Rite of Election



How strange this title sounds to us! While many of us would probably agree that our national, state and local elections are rituals of a special breed, we hardly expect to find a “rite of election” in church. But long before any of our ancestors thought of electing their leaders, God was electing a people, selecting Israel, a rag-tag clan in a tiny corner of the earth, to be special, holy, a chosen people. God did not choose them because they were noteworthy in any way; they were not powerful, strong or particularly clever. But once they were chosen, they were God's forever. Even when they strayed, looking to other gods for hope or help, God clung to them fiercely, calling them back again and again when anyone else would have gladly let them go.

It is the same with us. God chooses us, elects us, in Christ, to be a holy people, to be a church, to be signs of the reign of God on earth. The catechumens who have been preparing for baptism and those who have been working with them for months and years believe that God has chosen them to be one of us, the baptized. At the rite of election, their godparents, sponsors, catechists, pastors and friends will testify before the bishop that God has chosen these people. They will offer the evidence of their lives among us, hearing and following God's word, praying with God's people and taking part in the work and the communal life of God's church. After

listening to this testimony, the bishop will declare that they are elected for baptism, chosen to be God's own in Christ Jesus—not because they earned it, but because God wants it. And that is election by a landslide!
