## OUR LENTEN JOURNEY

**Praying:** Stations of the Cross every Friday of Lent  
7:00 pm in English and 7:45 in Spanish.

**Fasting:** Throughout the Lenten season we fast in many ways, from food, from harmful practices, from gossip or from using a sharp tongue. We fast within the liturgy itself by not singing the Alleluia or the Gloria. We fast visually with the sparseness of our church decor. The obligatory days of fasting from food during Lent are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence, we abstain from eating red meat and poultry. Unless hindered by health reasons, all over the age of 14 are obligated to abstain from meat on Fridays. In observing this weekly day of abstinence we commit ourselves to journey as Christ's Body. You are welcome to come to our weekly Lenten dinners here at St. Linus every Friday of Lent in the parish hall beginning at 5:00 p.m.

**Almsgiving:** "My Lenten Offering" cards

At the doors of the church you will find our "Lenten offering" cards which we invite you to take home. For each of the 40 days of Lent there is a slot for you to put a quarter. You will be asked to return the cards on Easter Sunday. This is an opportunity we have to share our gifts with others and to teach our children about sharing and thinking of the less fortunate. The proceeds gathered will go toward Mustard Seed Communities, St. Augustine in the Philippines, Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe in Baja California and toward our Parish Food Pantry.

### Lenten Liturgies at St. Linus

During the season of Lent we will:

- Kneel during the Penitential Rite as an act of penance
- Respond "God of Mercy, hear our prayer" at the General Intercessions
- Chant the "Our Father"
- Have silence after communion
- Pray the "Christ Prayer"
- Exchange the Family Prayer Box
