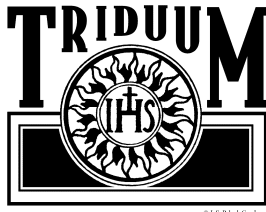

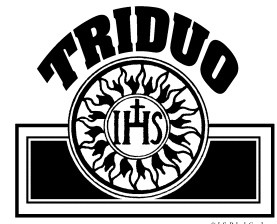

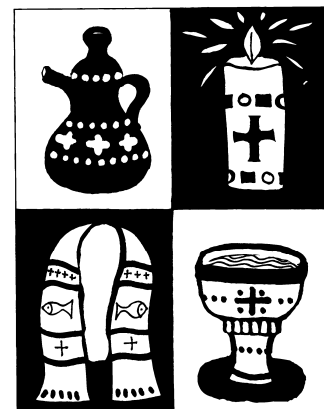
Then come to these waters to be reborn. Enter this bath to be made clean. Step into this tomb and die to all that has been so that you may live for all that truly is.
