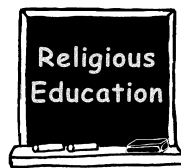

QUESTIONS ABOUT VOCATIONS

What if I feel unworthy?

Then you are in good company. Simon Peter told Jesus, "Depart from me, for I am sinful man." Yet Jesus called him. No one is actually "worthy". We don't earn God's call. Jesus said, "It is not you who chose me, but I who chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit that will last. (Jn. 15:16)

How do I go about making this decision?

The process of working out where you are called is known as discernment. Discernment is a process of listening to inner movements and learning to sift out what is from God and what is not from God. Please refer to the "Discernment" section for a fuller explanation of the discernment process.

Will I have to give up friends and family in order to join?

No, in fact friends and family are a very important support for priests, sisters, and brothers. However, the demands of the people of God or; a religious community get priority in terms of your time and energy. In this sense you "let go" of family and friends. Remember Jesus' promise in the Gospel according to Matthew: "And everyone who has given up houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or lands for the sake of my name will receive a hundred times more, and will inherit eternal life." Mt. 19:29.

What if I'm afraid of making a permanent commitment?

Seminary and initial formation give you the time and space to really see if priesthood or religious life fit before you make any kind of commitment. What is most important is to stay in conversation with God. No matter what twists and turns it takes, you will be faithful in the end to whatever commitment you are called to live out.

What if one of my personal beliefs clash with that of the institutional church?

Do you think that St. Martin de Porres, the mixed-race Peruvian slave who doctored and fed the poor of Lima, was comfortable with the institutional Church's position on slavery? There are great saints who challenged the institutional Church during their lifetimes, and great Catholics today who do the same. There is a prophetic dimension to our Catholic tradition.

A MASS WITH A HEALING SERVICE

In each of us is the natural desire to search for the one we love. Fr. Patrick was the youngest of three sons, born in Mission, Texas and raised by Catholic loving parents. After leaving home for college, his faith played less and less role in his life while money began to play a greater role in his life. He was consumed with the idea of money as the road to richness and success. Degrees in Economics and Finance led to careers in Banking and Real Estate. In the eyes of the world, he had everything he needed and wanted, yet there was a profound emptiness in his life. He realized that what he was missing was true and authentic love. Through the encouragement of friends, he answered the call to see Christ in his priesthood, a call that he initially resisted.

Fr. Patrick lived and studied in Rome, Italy, literally under the shadows of St. Peter's Basilica and the late Pope John Paul II. His time in Rome provided him the valuable experience in the study of theology and the experience of the universal church. He was ordained for the Diocese of Orange on June 7, 2003 and was assigned to St. Polycarp for three months and was sent back to Rome for more academic studies.

His journey to the priesthood has not been easy; Father met his own weaknesses and failings but understands that he will never be the owner of the priestly vocation he has received – that he belongs to Christ – the love and the One whom he has been searching for. Father Moses serves as the parochial vicar of St. Irenaeus Church in Cypress, CA. Come and experience the healing power of the Spirit!
