While the slogan for our fundraising campaign is “Pray Cool in ‘06”, we are actually wanting to install a new heating and cooling system in the church.

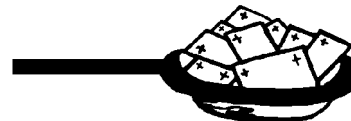

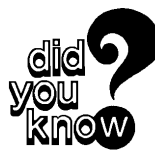

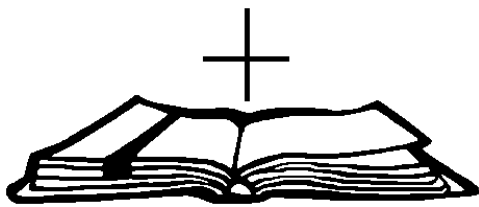
