TOWN HALL MEETING

**There will be a Town Hall Meeting
Monday, May 15 at 7:00 PM in McNulty Hall**

All Parishioners are urged to attend. We will:

1. Look at the shortage of priests in our Archdiocese and what that means both for the Archdiocese and for our Parish.
2. Look at our Parish, its life and ministries, strengths and weaknesses, with a view toward insuring that we will continue the strengths and develop those areas that are weak in the future. These will be prioritized. The question we must answer for the Archdiocese is: *"With the likelihood that the parishes of our Archdiocese will have fewer priests in the coming years, how will our parish provide for the ministries, services, and pastoral leadership that our people will need."*
3. Set out alternate Parish leadership proposals as outlined by the Archdiocese. The results of this meeting will be published as an insert in the bulletin.
4. Our results will be used for our own future planning. In addition, they will be forwarded to the San Pedro Regional Office and collated with the Deanery and region during the summer. In the fall there will be a meeting of Archdiocesan leadership to put together an overall Archdiocesan strategy to insure the future vitality of our Church in Los Angeles.

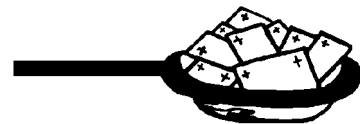
Please keep an eye out for a thermometer around the church to watch our collection grow.

RETIREMENT FUND FOR ARCHDIOCESAN PRIESTS

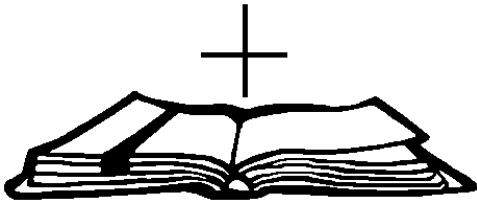
