 Total donated so far: **\$9100.00**

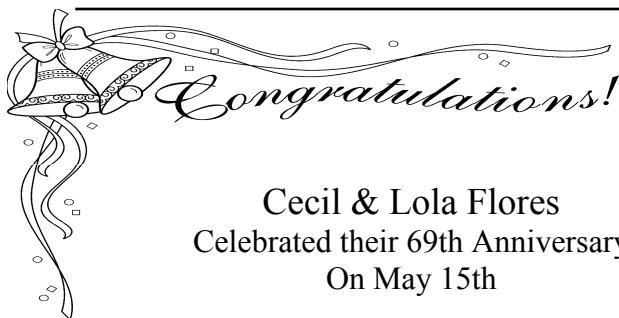

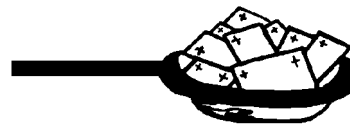

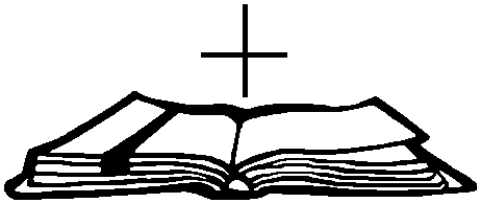
