So we are asking you **to PLEASE refrain from placing candles on the floor at the side altars.** All candles placed on the floor will be removed for the safety of others.

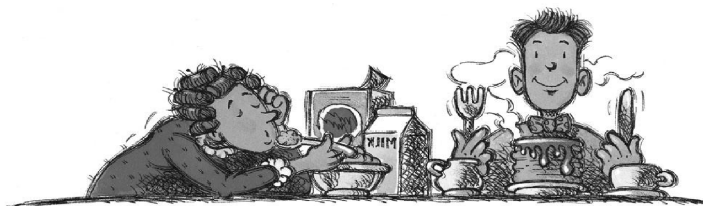

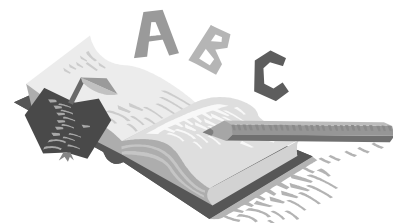
