## PENTECOST LITURGY

Next Sunday is the solemnity of Pentecost-the day the Church commemorates the sending of the Holy Spirit, 50 days after the Resurrection. In observance of this, we will celebrate the Pentecost Vigil on Saturday evening at 5:30 pm. The custom of a vigil dates back to the earliest days of the church. The early Christian communities would gather the night before the Lord's Day and would keep watch throughout the night. In doing this they were a living example of Jesus' parable of the ten bridesmaids. They kept their lamps burning throughout the night, waiting and watching for the return of the bridegroom. In the same way, the church gathers in the night, which leads to the Lord's Day, watching and waiting in anticipation for his return. The vigil for Pentecost has the added dimension of mirroring the apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary. Locked in the upper room, they waited and watched as well. Jesus had instructed them, on the day of his ascension to wait for the Holy Spirit.

In this same way, we too, will wait and watch, praying for the fulfillment of Christ' promises to us. Pentecost Sunday, May 11, celebrates the fulfillment of Jesus' promise to send the Holy Spirit to the church to act as teacher, counselor, advocate and helper-the one who will show us how to speak. On the solemnity of Pentecost we will conclude the Easter season with truly festive and solemn liturgies.

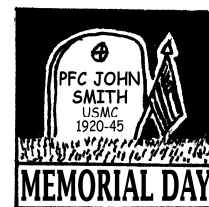

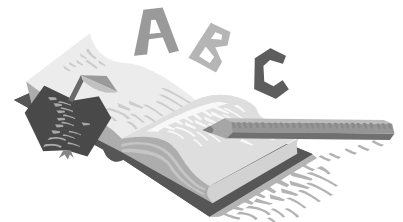
