Catholic Relief Services Collection for the Typhoon in the Philippines

The sixth tropical cyclone to strike the shores of the Philippines this year, the Category 3 (serious) Typhoon Frank managed to hit almost the entire country, causing sever flooding as it passed through. It first caused massive devastation in Mindanao, across the Visayas, in the capital Manila and northwestern Luzon between June 21 and 22.

Dioceses across the country are reporting major devastation at their doorsteps, and the urgent needs of people arriving at them. The typhoon cause great destruction in some parishes, especially in the low-lying areas, damaging houses, properties, as well and corn and rice fields.

Catholic Relief Services and its partner, the National Secretariat for Social Action-Justice and Peace, is responding with emergency relief for 50,000 people in six provinces.

THE MERCY, POWER, AND LOVE OF GOD

The first reading today, from the book of Wisdom, makes its point over and over, at least five times in five verses! God is mighty, but lenient to all.
