This evening we will pray over participants attending the Steubenville San Diego Conference experience and enjoy a pasta dinner as a community. Youth Ministry - Fall Kick Off - Retreat

All high school teenagers, those in the process toward confirmation, those already confirmed and any other young people who might be interested are invited to LIFE TEEN’s Fall Semester Kick off. All meetings are to be held in the parish Hall.

Community Dinner

In cooperation with youth ministry, the parents and young people attending Steubenville San Diego Conference invite you to a delicious pasta dinner tonight immediately following the LIFE TEEN Mass. The evening will be an opportunity to come together as community and enjoy a meal in addition to acknowledge and give a prayerful send off to all of the participants and chaperones who will be attending the conference. Steubenville SD is one of fifteen youth rallies offered by Franciscan University, that invite teens into a life-changing relationship with Jesus Christ and enable them to be filled with the Holy Spirit. **PASTORAL LETTER TO CATHOLIC FAITHFUL IN THE
ARCHDIOCESE OF LOS ANGELES**

July 18, 2007

As you have heard, this past week our Archdiocese settled 508 civil cases involving clergy and lay persons accused of sexual abuse. The emotional pain of the victims of this abuse remains intense, and I invite each of you to join with me in praying for them on their difficult journey toward healing.

I again apologize personally, and on behalf of those who led the church in past decades, to all those who were abused, regardless of how long ago the abuse took place.

As much as we might wish that the past could be reversed and the harm undone, it cannot be. But we can work to ensure that our parish ministries are as safe as we can humanly make them for all of our parishioners, especially our children and young people.

Throughout our Archdiocese, in our parishes and schools, our priests and lay people have worked hard over the past several years to create safe environments for our children. At this important moment in our Local Church's history, as we remember our past failings, it is also appropriate to reflect on what has been accomplished so far:

- . There is no priest or lay person currently in ministry in the Archdiocese who has been found to have abused a young person.
- . Complaints of abuse are promptly reported to civil authorities.
- . A Clergy Misconduct Oversight Board receives complaints of inappropriate conduct and makes recommendations about the disposition of individual cases.
- . More than 40,000 priests, teachers, lay employees, coaches and volunteers have been trained in abuse prevention techniques under the Archdiocese's Safeguard the Children program.
- . Before being allowed to work alone with children, church employees and volunteers are being fingerprinted and will clear a criminal background check.
- . More than 350,000 of our children and youth already have been trained in age-appropriate programs that teach them to distinguish between appropriate and inappropriate behavior and how to report inappropriate behavior to a parent or guardian.

Again, I invite you to join me in fervent prayer for the healing of all victims of sexual abuse, and for reconciliation across the Archdiocese.

CARTA PASTORAL A LOS FIELES CATOLICOS DE LA ARQUIDIOCESIS DE LOS ANGELES

18 de julio de 2007

Como ustedes habrán escuchado, la semana pasada la Arquidiócesis de Los Angeles llegó a un acuerdo legal en relación a 508 casos que involucran a clérigos y a empleados laicos de la Arquidiócesis acusados de abuso sexual. El dolor emocional de las víctimas aún es intenso, y los invito a todos y a cada uno de ustedes a que se unan conmigo para orar por ellos.

De nueva cuenta, personalmente y en nombre de aquellos que dirigieron la Iglesia en las décadas pasadas, pido perdón a todos los que fueron abusados, sin importar el tiempo que haya pasado desde que sucedió el abuso.

Si pudiéramos, haríamos todo lo que estuviera al alcance de nuestras manos para cambiar el pasado y borrar el daño causado, pero esto no es posible. Sin embargo, trabajaremos para que nuestros ministerios parroquiales sean lo más humanamente seguros para nuestros feligreses, especialmente nuestros niños y jóvenes.

En toda nuestra Arquidiócesis, en nuestras parroquias y en nuestras escuelas, nuestros sacerdotes y personal laico han trabajado en los últimos años incansablemente para crear un ambiente seguro para nuestros niños. En este momento tan importante en la historia de nuestra Iglesia Local, al mismo tiempo que reconocemos nuestros errores pasados, también es apropiado señalar lo que hemos implementado responsablemente:

- No hay ningún sacerdote o laico en ningún ministerio de la Arquidiócesis que haya abusado de un menor.
- Las acusaciones de abuso son inmediatamente reportadas a las autoridades civiles.
- La Comisión de Comportamiento de Mala Conducta de Clero recibe las acusaciones de conductas inapropiadas y hace las recomendaciones para que se tomen las medidas en cada caso individual.
- Más de 40,000 sacerdotes, maestros, empleados laicos, entrenadores y voluntarios han sido capacitados sobre técnicas de prevención de abusos en el programa de la Arquidiócesis: *Protegiendo a los Niños*.
- Antes de ser permitidos a trabajar con niños sin la presencia de otros adultos, todos los empleados y los voluntarios de la Iglesia pasan por un proceso de revisión de sus huellas digitales y un chequeo de su historial criminal.
- Más de 350,000 de nuestros niños y nuestros jóvenes han recibido un entrenamiento de acuerdo a su edad para distinguir cuándo la conducta de un adulto no es adecuada y también sobre cómo reportar esas conductas inapropiadas a sus padres or guardianes.
