Prior to ordination, a candidate for priesthood goes through a lengthy evaluation period, including an internship during which he lives in a rectory and works with priests, staff and parishioners. During this time, the candidate is judged as to his suitability to be a priest. No one is ordained unless the staff of St. John's Seminary, including the lay faculty and formation advisers, concludes that the candidate has attained an emotional, psychological and sexual maturity appropriate for his age and for the celibate life of a priest. 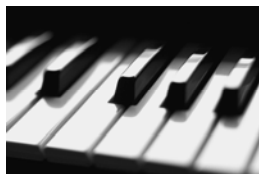
PM, and sponsors on Sunday, September 30 from 1 -4:15 PM. All meetings are to be held in the parish Hall.

The following is some news directly from Brother Garvin, Director of Mustard Seed Communities' programs in Zimbabwe (formerly Rhodesia), Africa.

There is a major crisis developing in Zimbabwe which has led us to contemplate suspending some of our activities. There are electricity cuts from 6 to 8 hours every day and the water supply has been cut off in most areas until further notice. Fortunately we have a borehole but we can't reach the water without electricity for the pump. The fuel supply is running dry so we are limiting our movements to save gas. To crown it all, there is no food in the shops! Many stores are closing and all of our sources are diminishing.

We have had to make the hard decision to temporarily suspend our feeding programs. This will mean that our 500 to 600 children will have no means of getting a meal. It has become extremely difficult.

We are pursuing every possibility but importation of goods is restricted and monitored.

Solutions are not forthcoming, so we have resorted to a massive prayer schedule.

We will find a solution. Just continue to pray for us please.
