## Did you know?

### Safety tips for children traveling alone

Take time to discuss appropriate behavior with your child before he or she boards an airplane alone. If another passenger acts in an inappropriate way, be sure that your child knows to inform a flight attendant or other airline representative. Inappropriate behavior on the part of other passengers includes rude, offensive, or threatening comments; inappropriate touching; inappropriate conversations; taking food or other items away from the child; or other behavior that makes the child uncomfortable or fearful. In addition, inappropriate behavior would include any attempt to elicit personal information about the child. Make sure that your child understands that no passenger they meet needs to know things such as their full name, their home address, their telephone number, or where they are going.

## Ordinary Time during Summer and Fall

The season after Pentecost resumes Ordinary Time, the longest season of the liturgical year, spanning three seasons of nature, late spring, summer and fall. Ordinary time begins the Monday after Pentecost. During Ordinary Time, tradition marks certain days to remember and celebrate the saints, a title of Mary or Jesus, or a mystery of faith. There are four movable solemnities of the Lord: The Most Holy Trinity, The Most Holy body and Blood of Christ, the sacred Heart of Jesus, and Our Lord Jesus Christ the King. The first two solemnities are the first two Sundays in ordinary time, the third always falls on the Friday after the Most Holy Body and Blood and the fourth is always the last Sunday in Ordinary Time, with which we end our liturgical year.

Please be reminded that we call this season “ordinary” not because it is common or unexceptional but because now we count the number of Sundays until Advent, at which time a new liturgical year begins.
