I would like to update you on the major projects that have been completed during the past year and one half. **CHURCH:** replaced the carpet, put new tile under the pews, rebuilt side altar kneelers, and built a Divine Mercy Shrine. New kneelers have been installed, bathrooms have been refurbished, and a handicapped bathroom created. We had the Edison Company do an energy survey for us and, as a result, new EXIT signs and energy efficient bulbs were installed in the church and parish hall. This has made a difference in our monthly electric bills. **PARISH HALL:** gum was removed from lunch grounds, area behind the parish hall was cemented and there are plans to install a small shed back there to store unsightly items that are left in the patio area and lastly, the Knights of Columbus donated several new light weight tables. **Parish Center:** front office, two meeting rooms, and bathroom were painted and refurbished. We were very fortunate to be the recipient of two **Eagle Scout Projects.** The first was cabinets built and installed in the parish hall pantry. The second was the creation of a patio at the parish center. This area can be used for meetings during the warm months. **School:** restrooms and the parking lot fence were painted. We were able to accomplish these projects because of your generous donations to our Building Fund and proceeds from our Oktoberfest. I would also like to thank Dennis and Dean Adame, and Clem Linnebur for the work they do to help keep costs down. If you see things around the parish grounds that need attention please call the parish office and let me know your concerns.

**The Prevalence of Abuse in Society**

In surveys of adults, one out of five women and one out of ten men reported that they were sexually molested before they were 18 years old. This means that an estimated 40 million adult survivors of child sexual abuse are living in the United States today. An estimated 9.6% of all school children will be molested by an educator or an employee of a school between kindergarten and 12th grade. Between 13 and 34% of all females will be victims of sexual assault before the age of 18, and 7 to 16% of all males will also be victimized before they are 18.
