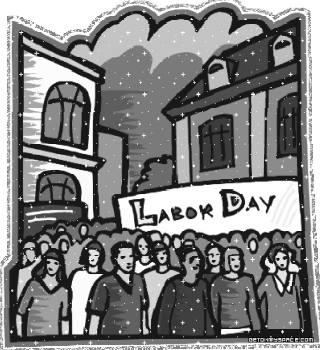

Youth Ministry/LIFE TEEN

LIFE Nights are catechetical meetings that immediately follow the Youth Mass on Sunday evening from 7:15 - 8:45 PM and take place in the parish hall unless otherwise noted. Teens in preparation for confirmation are expected to attend most nights.

Our first LIFE Night and Fall Kick off is Sunday September 28. This night will welcome back our teenagers from their busy summers and help new teens entering youth ministry feel welcome, meet new people, and understand the importance of their involvement in Youth Ministry.

The LIFE Night the following Sunday, October 5 launches our semester theme of educational nights, where the focus is the Person of Christ. "A River Runs Through It" is about our response to God's free gift of Himself. This night will provide teens with the definition of faith and the role the Church plays in our faith.

This summer was a time of organization and re-organization. During the process many exciting treasures were found in the youth room that are no longer used for ministry. You can reap the benefits. Sunday, September 14, Youth Ministry will host a rummage sale and hospitality after all Masses, including our Noon Mass. Fall begins on September 22, so to celebrate our families, and gear up for autumn Youth Ministry is hosting a summer send-off. All families are invited to come to the LIFE TEEN Mass early. Arrive at 4:19 PM to play organized family games and start praising early. Bring blankets to sit on and a picnic dinner to enjoy after mass on the benches outside the hall. It's sure to be a great way to enjoy a time of fellowship, build community, bid farewell to the dog days of summer, and transition into the new school year.

Youth Confirmation

Registration and re-registration materials were mailed out to teens and their families for this upcoming ministry year at the beginning of June. Between the young people being invited to youth ministry and those expected to return, approximately 100 letters were sent. It was asked that all registration materials (the form, a copy of baptismal certificate, a photo of teen and registration fee) be turned in by last Sunday, August 24. As of that date merely 24 new and 18 returning teens turned in even a partial registration. Thank you to the teens and parents who turned all materials in on time, but this response is not representative of the number of young people in our parish.

If you have not returned your registration materials or know of teenagers who are in high school and should be in youth ministry to deepen their relationship with Christ and His church or enrolled in the initiation process of confirmation through their involvement in youth ministry, please contact them and encourage them to register. The extended deadline is now September 7. The youth ministry office thanks you in advance for your attention to promptness.

Parents of youth invited to enter Phase 2 of Confirmation preparation are required to attend an orientation session with their teen on Thursday, September 11 from 7-9 PM in the Parish Hall. A session for **candidates and sponsors** will follow on Sunday, September 28, from 1-4:30 PM also in the Hall. Parents of youth entering LIFE TEEN for the first time are required to attend an orientation session with their teen on Thursday evening, September 18, also from 7-9 PM.
