#### CyberTipline Fights Internet Crimes Against Children

The National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and other government agencies all work together to fight Internet crimes against children. They've established a "CyberTipline," a reporting mechanism for cases of child sexual exploitation including child pornography, online enticement of children for sex acts, molestation of children outside the family, sex tourism of children, child victims of prostitution, and unsolicited obscene material sent to a child. All parish families are invited, parents and families of teenagers are particularly encouraged to attend.

### Martha's House Update Jamaica



Thanks to the incredible generosity of our supporters, the rebuilding of Martha's House is nearly complete! The original land that Martha's House sat on was leased to Mustard Seed and that lease was to expire in the next five years, so instead of rebuilding on that site, the decision was made to rebuild Martha's House on the campus of Jerusalem! in Spanish Town. Building began at the new site in July and is essentially complete! Six cottages were built to house a total of 30 children. There is a gazebo between the cottages where the children will have plenty of room to play. There was already a structure present that will house the main kitchen, the laundry, the office and a room for the children to have classes. MSC is incredibly grateful for the speed at which support poured in and as a result that the construction has taken place quickly as well. We hope to move the children in as soon as possible.
