This week, the parish office received the following information from the Archdiocese.

In order to give Bishop Solis the opportunity of the pastoral ministry as a Regional Bishop and to have Bishop Salazar assist the Cardinal with important pastoral initiatives, the Cardinal has decided to make this lateral transfer of the two Bishops. Effective September 30, 2009 Bishop Solis will become the Regional Bishop for the San Pedro Region and Bishop Salazar will join the Cardinal in the Archdiocesan Catholic Center.

September 20: Mass on the Grass – Pre-Mass activities for the whole family start at 4:30 PM, Burgers and Hot Dogs will be available for a free will donation after mass along with a friendly game of volleyball in the hall. All parish families are invited, parents and families of teenagers are particularly encouraged to attend.

September 27: “Give It Away, Now! The Can It Edition” - Global LIFE Night and Parish-wide Canned food drive.

Join Life Teen and let’s fight hunger together! Life Teen is having a canned food drive the weekend of September 27. Bring canned food items to church and drop them off in the bins in the vestibule. Our food drive is part of Life Teen’s 2nd Annual Global Charity Night.
